**Specific to:**

Pat & Barry viewed integrity and leadership essential for our future. Each year two or more bursaries are awarded from this Fund recognizing these skills and attributes.

**Criteria:**

(who should apply)

The person receiving this bursary:

- will be an Oxford County rural youth or youth coming from an Oxford County town or village with a population of less than 5,000 residents
- will have demonstrated leadership potential. They will have developed themselves and just as importantly others in school, community or in sports.
- may additionally have a combination of education, sports or community involvement.

<b>Criteria:</b> (who should apply?)	<p>The person who will be awarded this bursary will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• reside in Oxford County</li><li>• be enrolled at The Ontario Agriculture College at the University of Guelph and/or the Department of Family Relations and Applied Nutrition in the College of Social &amp; Applied Human Sciences at the University of Guelph</li><li>• excel in leadership skills demonstrating they have developed themselves and others, either in the schools or in their community</li><li>• may additionally have a combination of school and community involvement</li></ul>

## **Student Award** **OCF Klosler Family Fund Bursary**

- Minimum of two references verifying good character and drive.

The euphoria of winning is to hug your teammates and say, "we found a way" to accomplish something great.'

**Selection Process:** IDCI’s Athletic Department Head shall select an athlete in memory of Tyler Arts, recognizing strength of character, competitiveness, and ability to bring teammates together.
